Policy Title:	Alcoholic Beverages Policy

Purpose:	To protect the parish of St. Peter the Apostle Antiochian Orthodox Church of San Dimas from potential legal liability or wrong doing.

BACKGROUND

There are several concerns:

- 1. Our parish is not licensed to sell alcoholic beverages.
- 2. If alcoholic beverages are served at a parish-sponsored event, and someone damages property or harms either himself or someone else while under the influence of alcohol, the parish could be legally and financially liable.
- 3. Our current liability insurance does not protect us from consequences related to the distribution and consumption of alcohol.
- 4. Some of the members of this parish may struggle with alcoholism.
- 5. It is illegal in California to sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 21 or encourage underage drinking.

This policy does **not** apply to non-parish events such as community events, private parties, members' behavior within their own homes, and other events not sponsored by our parish.

RULES

- Alcoholic beverages must not be sold at any parish-sponsored function or event.
- Alcoholic beverages may only be provided at a parish-sponsored function or event with the prior approval of the parish council.

GUIDELINES

- Alcoholic beverages may be provided at a parish-sponsored function or event (without charge) when appropriate measures are taken to ensure that:
 - No person under the age of 21 obtains, handles, or consumes an alcoholic beverage provided at the function or event, and
 - The amount of alcohol consumed at the function or event is controlled so no one becomes intoxicated to the point of posing a potential threat to property, self, or others.
- When appropriate and applicable, the pastor should remind people to drink responsibility.
- At parish-sponsored events to which the public is invited, designated persons should be responsible for the dispensing of alcoholic beverages.
